## **TERMS AND CONDITIONS / RESERVATIONS AND PAYMENTS**

### **BOOKING ARRANGEMENTS**

Reservations can be made by contacting The Global Safari Group, Inc, hereinafter referred to as the "Company." A deposit of 35 % is required at time of booking. Final payment is due 90 days prior to departure. The Company will not provide tickets, vouchers or documents until full payment and all waiver forms have been received by the Company. The Company will not be responsible for wire transfers and/or overnight mail charges.

### **CANCELLATIONS AND REFUNDS**

Cancellations received 90 days or more prior to departure are subject to a \$500 per person cancellation penalty; cancellations received 89-60 days prior to departure 20% of the total tour rate; cancellations received 59-45 days 50% of tour rate; cancellations received 44 days or less and 'no shows' total cost of tour is forfeited. Travel insurance is highly recommended.

*Cancellation penalties on airline tickets are additional and will depend on policies of the individual carriers. Most tickets are nonrefundable, trip cancellation' insurance is recommended.*

### **CHANGES**

Any request to amend or change a booking once it has been confirmed may be accommodated subject to availability. If the Company is able to assist, an administrative fee of \$100 per change will be assessed along with any additional charges mandated by the change.

No refunds are given for Itineraries amended after departure, leaving the program after it has begun, failure to participate in any scheduled activities, meals or accommodations, lost travel time or substitution of facilities: any circumstances arising beyond the Company's control necessitating alternative arrangements to ensure the safety of the client.

### **TOUR PRICES**

Rates for all tours are quoted in US dollars. Rates are subject to adjustment in the event of changes in Tariffs and /or rates of exchange.

### **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION**

The Company is only the booking agent for hotels, airlines, air charters, boat purveyors, bus companies, and other independent contractors providing transportation, accommodations and/or other services abroad. Each of the companies is an independent corporation with its own management and is not subject to the control of the Company.

The Company cannot be held liable for any personal injury or property damage which may arise out of these services as all services provided the overseas operators are subject to the terms and conditions contained in the vouchers issued by them and/or their suppliers. The Company reserves the right to cancel an itinerary or any part of it to make such alterations in the itinerary and accommodations as it deems necessary or desirable, to refuse to accept or to retain as a member of any program any person at any time and to pass on to program members any expenditure occasioned by delays or events beyond its control.

The Company draws your attention to the fact that there are certain inherent risks involved in International and adventure travel sold by the Company and that you accept them at your own risk. Waivers will be sent to you and must be signed/returned before documents are issued.

It is the travelers sole responsibility to take any and all appropriate medical advice given prior to departure as to whether or not you are fit enough to undertake the type of trip you have booked. The Company shall not be liable for illness, injury or death sustained on a program sold by the Company which is not due to the gross negligence of the Company, its officers, employees, or authorized representatives.

The Company will not be held responsible for any circumstances beyond its reasonable control, including but without limitation, acts of God, explosion, flood tempest, fire, war or threat of war, sabotage, insurrection, civil disturbance, or requisition sickness, quarantine, government intervention, weather conditions or other untoward occurrences.

The Company shall not be deemed in breach of these terms and conditions or otherwise be liable to you, by reason of delay in performance, or by non-performance, of any of its obligations there under to the extent that any such delay or non-performance is due to circumstances beyond reasonable control.

Some departures require a minimum number of passengers to operate; options will be given if group does not materialize.

#### SURCHARGES

Quoted tour prices are based on current rates of exchange, tariffs and taxes. The Global Safari Group, Inc. reserves the right to increase tour prices to cover increased costs, tariffs and taxes and to reflect fluctuations in foreign exchange market. The Company will notify you in writing as soon as the Company has been made aware of any surcharge. You must pay the amount of such surcharge no later than ten (10) days after written notification has been received (depending on circumstances). If the surcharge is not paid within such time, the company may construe such non-payment as an act of cancellation on your part and cancellation charges will apply.

#### SPECIAL REQUESTS

Special requests must be received in writing (e.g. diet, physically handicapped or other) at time of reservation. The company will make every effort to meet these requests.

#### CARRIAGE/BAGGAGE

Transportation by Air, Land and sea is subject to the terms and conditions of the carrier with whom you are traveling and to international conventions, some of which may have limited liability. Air, land and sea travel may also be subject to operational decisions of carriers and ports which may result in cancellation, delays or diversions, over which the Company has no control and for which the Company accepts no liability whatsoever. Loss of baggage, temporarily or permanently, is the responsibility of you and/or the carrier.

#### AFRICA SMALL CHARTERED FLIGHTS

Baggage limits on small charter aircraft vary between airlines and countries. Restrictions will be advised as they can change at any time.

#### AIR TRANSPORTATION

The Company will assist in making air arrangements; the best airfare will be quoted in the class of service you request at the time of booking. Certain airfares are subject to service fees, cancel or change fee should you change or cancel before or after your departure. Air tickets will not be issued until payment and copies of passport is received by Company.

#### HEALTH
